ORDER NO. 11
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of notice of Undine Texas Environmental, LLC's application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris County.

On January 4, 2023, Undine filed the following: (1) the affidavit of Carey Thomas, senior vice president of Undine, attesting that notice was mailed to current customers, landowners, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on December 21, 2022; and (2) a publisher's affidavit attesting to the publication of notice in the *Houston Business Journal*, a newspaper of general circulation in Harris, Chambers, Liberty, Montgomery, Waller, Fort Bend, Brazoria, and Galveston counties, on December 2 and 9, 2022. On March 16, 2023, Undine filed the affidavit of Vance Tillman, Undine's chief financial officer, attesting that Undine provided notice to Texas Water Utilities, LP on March 14, 2023. On April 6, 2023, Undine filed clarification regarding the maps that were included with the notices that were mailed on December 21, 2022.


On April 14, 2023, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient and establishes the following procedural schedule.
