**COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

**I. INTRODUCTION**

On July 14, 2022, Undine Texas LLC (Undine) and Nitsch and Son Utility Company, Inc. (Nitsch) (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris County. Specifically, Applicants seeks approval to acquire facilities and to transfer water service area held under Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 13260.

On April 17, 2023, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 11, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to request a hearing or file a final recommendation on approval of the sale and certificate of convenience and necessity amendment by May 15, 2023. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

**II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff needs additional time to evaluate the application before filing a final recommendation. As such, Staff respectfully requests that the deadline to June 1, 2023. Staff conferred with Nitsch and is authorized to represent they are unopposed to the proposed extension. Staff also attempted to confer with Undine but was unsuccessful.

**III. CONCLUSION**

For the reasons detailed above, Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the above request for extension.
