This Order addresses the sufficiency of supplemental notice filed on June 8, 2023 of Undine Texas Environmental, LLC's application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris County.


On June 8, 2023, Undine filed an affidavit signed by Carey Thomas, senior vice president of Undine, stating that there are no owners of any tracts of land that are at least twenty-five acres that are wholly or partially included in the area proposed to be certified.

On June 26, 2023, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on the supplemental notice.

The administrative law judge finds the supplemental notice sufficient. The deadlines established in Order No. 12 remain in effect.
