**ORDER NO. 7**  
**FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND REQUIRING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of Undine Texas Environmental, LLC's proof of notice in this application. On January 24, 2023, Undine provided the affidavit of Vance Tillman, Undine's chief financial officer, attesting that mailed notice was provided on January 13, 2023, to landowners, neighboring utilities, and affected parties, with maps. Undine also provided a publisher's affidavit dated December 8, 2022, showing that notice was published in the *Fort Bend Herald*, a newspaper of general circulation in Fort Bend County, on November 24, and 29, 2022.

On February 13, 2023, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding Undine's provision of notice.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds that the applicant has satisfied the notice requirements of 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.253(c) and that no further notice is required.

By February 22, 2023, Commission Staff must file a proposed procedural schedule.
