**ORDER NO. 7  
FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND SOLICITING  
PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE FOR CONTINUED PROCESSING**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Texas Water Utilities, LP and Creek Water Utility LLC.

On November 21, 2022, applicants filed the affidavit of George Freitag, Texas Water's Texas regulatory manager, attesting that notice, along with maps, was provided to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on November 18, 2022.

On December 28, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient.

By January 9, 2023, Commission Staff must file a proposed procedural schedule for continued processing.
