ORDER NO. 11
GRANTING EXTENSION AND AMENDING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On February 17, 2023, Commission Staff filed its third request for an extension stating discovery is ongoing. Specifically, four days before its request for a hearing or a recommendation on approval of the sale and the certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) amendment was due, it filed its third requests for information (RFIs) to Texas Water Utilities, LP. Four days later, on February 17, 2023, Texas Water Utilities filed its objections and responses to Commission Staff's third RFIs. Commission Staff states that it needs additional time to review the responses to the third RFIs and that Texas Water is unopposed to the proposed extension.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) grants Commission Staff's third request for an extension. No further extensions will be granted without a showing of good cause due to the impending 120-day statutory deadline.

The ALJ amends the procedural schedule as follows:

Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a recommendation on approval of the sale and the CCN amendment	February 24, 2023
Deadline for parties to file a response to Commission Staff's recommendation on approval of the sale	March 3, 2023
Deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving the sale and allowing the transaction to proceed	March 6, 2023
120-day deadline for the Commission to approval the sale or require a hearing	March 20, 2023 ¹

¹ The 120-day deadline falls on Saturday, March 18, 2023. The deadline moves to the next day the Commission is open for business, Monday, March 20, 2023, under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(a).
