**FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING
NOTICE, ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE, AND RESTYLING DOCKET**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the August 1, 2022 application of Skyline Drive Landowners Association Water System and Johnson County Special Utility District for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Johnson County. On December 19, 2022, the applicants filed an amended application.

On January 23, 2023, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application and notice.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application, as amended, administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application in the manner described in the January 23, 2023 memorandum of Jolie Mathis, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation, using the included forms.


The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Event	Date
Deadline for the applicants to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties and the newspaper tear sheets	February 22, 2023
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	March 6, 2023
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued

Further, the ALJ grants Commission Staff's request to restyle the docket which is reflected in this Order.
