**NOTICE OF APPROVAL**

This Notice of Approval addresses the August 3, 2022 application of Windrose Power and Gas, LLC to relinquish its retail electric provider (REP) certificate number 10254. The Commission approves Windrose's relinquishment of REP certificate number 10254.

The application was submitted on a commission-approved form, that was signed and verified by an executive officer. The application reflects that Windrose: (1) has no current customers in Texas because all of its customers were transferred to 4Change Energy and TXU Energy in March 2022; (2) does not owe any money to customers in Texas because all of the company's customer deposits were transferred to 4Change Energy and TXU Energy or were returned; and (3) provided the required notices to affected parties.

On September 26, 2022, Commission Staff recommended approval of the application.

The administrative law judge finds that Windrose's application meets the requirements of 16 Texas Administrative Code § 25.107 to relinquish its REP certificate.

The Commission approves the relinquishment of Windrose's REP certificate number 10254.<sup>1</sup>
