RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 7

COME NOW Oak Hill Estates Water Company, LLC ("Oak Hill") and CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC ("CSWR-Texas") and submits this response to Order No. 7. Order No. 7 directs CSWR-Texas to respond to the order by March 7, 2023. Accordingly, this response is timely filed.

I. CLARIFICATION REGARDING NOTICE

Order No. 7 directs CSWR-Texas and the Commission Staff to clarify whether references in the customer notices to "Pine Grove, Texas" are correct or may have caused confusion among recipients of the notice. Specifically, the notice indicates: ¹

The requested area includes 135 customer connections, is located approximately 1.4 mile(s) northeast of downtown Pine Grove, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by Harris and Montgomery County Line; on the east by Lee Road; on the south by Kennemer Drive and Field Cottage Lane; and on the west by Fox Walk Trail and Fox Swift Court.

CSWR-Texas and Commission Staff have reviewed the notice and discussed the administrative law judge's concerns. CSWR-Texas can confirm that, based on its discussion with Commission Staff, which drafted the final notice, there is a township called "Pine Grove, Texas" located in Harris County² and the reference to "Pine Grove, Texas" in the notice and the distance from the subject system is correct based on Staff's analysis. In addition, because of the relatively small area and clearly defined boundaries encompassing the requested area, other detailed information

included in the notice should avoid any potential confusion as to the requested area and customers affected by this proceeding.

Specifically, the notice included a general map that clearly defines the requested area within Harris County, the nearby county border with Montgomery County, and the nearby George Bush Intercontinental Airport, all of which are within the general vicinity of the requested area and are easily identifiable reference points. The notice also included a detailed map that clearly identifies the specific subdivision affected by the proposed transaction as well as specific streets and lots within that subdivision. The description of the requested area that was included in the notice also included detailed information regarding the location of the system that is readily identifiable and can be cross-referenced to the maps included with notice. Together, this information should have reasonably avoided any potential confusion as to the area and customers affected by this proceeding. For these reasons, the notice was adequate.

II. <u>CONCLUSION</u>

For these reasons, CSWR-Texas respectfully requests that the administrative law judge adopt the Proposed Order Approving the Sale and Transfer to Proceed that was previously filed in this proceeding and provide such other relief to which CSWR-Texas has shown itself justly entitled.

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

The deadline for intervention in the proceeding is (30 days from the mailing or publication of notice,

whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer). You must send a letter requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date. The letter must include the person's name, address, email address and fax number if applicable.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. 
