ORDER NO. 4
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING
NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the August 5, 2022 application of Stonetown Royal Coach Utilities, LLC and Trinity RCT Group LLC for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris County. On August 31, September 22, and September 26, 2022, the applicants supplemented the application.

On September 30, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application and notice.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application in the manner described in the September 23, 2022 memorandum of Jolie Mathis, attached to Commission Staff's September 30, 2022 recommendation, using the included forms.

The ALJ establishes the following procedural schedule:
