COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On August 5, 2022, Stonetown Royal Coach Utilities, LLC (Royal Coach) filed an application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris County.

On August 8, 2022, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 1, requiring Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice, and both Royal Coach and Commission Staff to file a recommendation regarding how to proceed with the application and propose a procedural schedule on or before September 6, 2022. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff is working with Royal Coach to obtain additional financial information to satisfy the requirements of 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.11. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests, and Royal Coach supports, an extension until September 23, 2022 for Staff to file its recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application.

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the issuance of an order consistent with the above request for extension.
