Shelly and Mike,
Once again, it is time to update your critical accounts.

In accordance with the Texas Water Code, electric utilities are required to make an annual determination if water facilities qualify for Critical Load designation. Per paragraph (f),: "Not later than May 1 of each year, each electric utility and each retail electric provider shall determine whether the facilities of the affected utility qualify for critical load status under rules adopted by the utility commission".

Please review, update and return your spreadsheet to our Critical Load team at criticalload@oncor.com by **March 31, 2023**. This is to allow us time to review and respond back by May 1.

Please note the following instructions:

- Populate Column B with either "Annual Renewal" or "Remove from Critical Load List" for each account currently listed
- If requesting to add additional accounts, insert the new ESI ID number to a new row at the bottom of the spreadsheet, and populate Column B with "New Critical Load Application"
- On new requests, please remember to complete all columns
- Please do not add columns or change column headings
- Please do not change the order of the columns
- When adding a new account, the ESI ID should be entered into Column D in text format
- Insert one ESI ID per row
- Highlight changes to existing ESI ID information, (color fill cell to indicate an update of information)
- Please complete the spreadsheet and email it to criticalload@oncor.com by March 31, 2023

As a reminder, please be aware that **designation of Critical Load does not guarantee an uninterrupted supply of electricity**. It is the responsibility of the Retail Customer to make arrangements for alternative sources of electric power should a load shed event or localized outage occur.

Dear Shelly Webb,

The electric service premise at 1661 S FM 548 in Royse City, ESI ID #10443720000271422, is now designated as a Critical Load Public Safety or Critical Load Industrial Customer as defined by the Public Utility Commission of Texas (PUCT) Substantive Rules 25.497(a) (1) "A customer for whom electric service is considered crucial for the protection or maintenance of public safety, including but not limited to hospitals, police stations, fire stations, and critical water and wastewater facilities", or (2) "An industrial customer for whom an interruption or suspension of electric service will create a dangerous or life-threatening condition on the retail customer's premises, is a critical load industrial customer."

Designation of a critical load does not guarantee an uninterrupted supply of electricity. It is the responsibility of the Retail Customer to make arrangements for alternative sources of electric power should a localized outage or load shed event occur.

As provided in Sections 4.2.5, 5.2.5, and 5.3.7.1 of Oncor's Tariff for Retail Delivery Service, Oncor shall, if reasonably possible, provide notice to Critical Load Public Safety and Critical Load Industrial Customers when Oncor curtails, reduces voltage, or interrupts delivery service during an emergency or other necessary event. Your location will be enrolled in the My Oncor Alerts program using the email address provided in the application. Oncor uses this program to communicate these types of events to our customers.
