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



RESPONSE:

As stated in the application San Bernard Electric Cooperative, Inc. (SBEC) estimates that providing a short overhead line to the development will cost \$11,961.10. The developer would contribute the full amount of \$11,961.10. This amount along with the cost they will contribute for the development inside the property, which is currently unknown, will be eligible for a portion to be refunded back to the developer.
