## GRANTING MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE AND APPROVING INTERIM RATES

### I. GRANTING MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE

SOAH Order No. 1 set a deadline (noon on August 24, 2022) for staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) to file its recommendation on the sufficiency of Entergy Texas, Inc.'s (ETI's) Application and notice. No recommendation was filed by that deadline. On August 25, 2022, Staff filed a motion seeking to extend its recommendation deadline to August 31, 2022. Staff

did not indicate whether ETI opposes the motion and Staff's requested extension date does not allow ETI to file a response to the motion within five working days.¹ However, given the relatively short extension requested by Staff and the ruling below, the ALJ finds good cause to grant Staff's motion without response from ETI. Accordingly, the motion is **GRANTED** and Staff's deadline to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of ETI's Application and proposed notice is

extended to on or before 4:00 p.m. on August 31, 2022.

SOAH Order No. 1 also set a deadline to object to ETI's request for interim approval of its revised fixed fuel factor. No objections were filed by the deadline. Accordingly, ETI's proposed revision to its fixed fuel factor is **APPROVED ON AN INTERIM BASIS effective August 25, 2022.** 

ETI shall file a copy of its Revised Fuel Factor (Schedule FF) with the Commission to be stamped as "Approved" by the Commission's Central Records Division.
