FINDING SUPPLEMENTAL PROOF OF NOTICE SUFFICIENT  
AND SOLCITING MOTION TO ADMIT EVIDENCE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the supplemental proof of notice provided by CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC. On August 16, 2023, CSWR-Texas filed the affidavit of Eric Rocchio, regulatory case manager of CSWR-Texas, attesting that there are no landowners owning tracts of land over 25 acres wholly or partly inside the requested area.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the supplemental proof of notice sufficient.

On or before August 24, 2023, CSWR-Texas must file a motion to admit the affidavit into evidence.
