JOINT PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On September 8, 2022, Quadvest LP (Quadvest) filed an application to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in Waller County. Quadvest holds water CCN No. 11612 and sewer CCN No. 20952.

On December 9, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 3, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to propose a procedural schedule by December 21, 2022. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

The ALJ found notice to be sufficient on December 9, 2022. Staff and Quadvest therefore proposes the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:

Deadline for Commission Staff to provide final maps, certificate, and tariffs (if applicable) to Quadvest for review and consent	March 15, 2023
Deadline for Quadvest to file its consent form with the Commission	March 29, 2023
Deadline for Commission Staff to request a hearing or file a final recommendation on the application	April 5, 2023
If no hearing is requested, deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact, including findings that address the factors in Texas Water Code § 13.246(c), and conclusions of law	April 12, 2023
