ORDER NO. 2
CLARIFYING SEVERANCE OF PROCEEDINGS

This Order provides clarifying information and additional instructions regarding the severance of the water and sewer portions of this application granted on February 8, 2024, in Order No. 16.

On February 6, 2024, Quadvest, LP and Commission Staff filed a joint motion to sever proceedings, lift abatement, restyle the docket and enter a procedural schedule in this application. The parties requested this docket be severed to allow for the water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) amendment application to proceed while Quadvest awaits the issuance of the final Texas Pollutant Discharge and Elimination System (TD PES) permit by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for the sewer CCN amendment.

On February 8, 2024, in Order No. 16 the administrative law judge (ALJ) granted the motion to sever, lifted the abatement, established a procedural schedule, and restyled Docket No. 54047. Also on February 8, 2024, the ALJ issued Order No. 1 in Docket No. 56192, styled the *Application of Quadvest, LP to Amend its Sewer Certificate of Convenience in Waller County*, abating the proceeding pending issuance of a TD PES permit, requesting monthly status reports or a request to lift the abatement with appropriate documentation from TCEQ regarding the TD PES

permit along with a procedural schedule for continued processing. Order No. 1 stated that all filings made in Docket No. 54047 were incorporated by reference into Docket No. 56192.

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.34, in the interest of efficiency, the administrative law judge (ALJ) severed Docket No. 54047 into two proceedings as follows:

1. Docket No. 54047 will continue to address the water CCN amendment.
2. Docket No. 56192 will address the sewer CCN amendment.
3. So that the record in both matters will be complete, the ALJ deems all documents filed prior to the date of this Order on the Commission's interchange in Docket No. 54047 to be incorporated by reference and also a part of the record for Docket No. 56192.
