ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of Quadvest, LP's September 8, 2022 application to amend its water and sewer certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) numbers 11612 and 20952 in Waller County.

On October 10, 2022, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness, provided instructions and forms for providing notice, and proposed a procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the petitioners to provide notice of the application as described in the October 10, 2022 memorandum of James Harville attached to Commission Staff's recommendation, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	December 8, 2022
Deadline to intervene	30 days after last date notice is issued
