COMMISSION STAFF'S RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 3

I. INTRODUCTION

On November 16, 2022, Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) filed its final recommendation regarding the petition of Kaufman Independent School District (Kaufman ISD) for streamlined expedited release from College Mound Water Supply Corporation's (College Mound WSC) water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 10825 in Kaufman County, under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h).

On November 29, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 3, directing the Staff of the Commission to file an updated final recommendation that includes a CCN certificate with the correct Docket No. by December 2, 2022. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. CORRECTED FINAL RECOMMENDATION

In its recommendation, Staff inadvertently attached the CCN certificate with the incorrect docket number. Staff respectfully files the corrected CCN certificate with the correct docket number.
