ORDER NO. 4 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND GRANTING EXTENSION

This Order addresses Commission Staff's request for an extension and recommendation on notice.

On November 14, 2022 Commission Staff filed a recommendation on sufficiency of the notice and a request for an extension.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the notice sufficient under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.363(b) and that no additional notice documentation is required. Further the ALJ grants the extension. By December 2, 2022, Commission Staff must request a hearing or file a recommendation on final disposition. Commission Staff has conferred with Harrison Williams and represents that he is not opposed to the extension.
