ORDER NO. 11 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT, ESTABLISHING EFFECTIVE DATE AND ADMITTING EVIDENCE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the re-issued notice filed on March 2, 2023, by Harris Williams, owner of SP Utility Company, Inc., and temporary manager of Villa Utilities. On April 3, 2023, Commission Staff filed its supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of notice and clarification in response to Order 9 and supplemental motion to admit evidence.

The administrative law judge grants Mr. Williams and Commission Staff's supplemental joint motion to admit evidence and admits Commission Staff's response to Order No. 9 filed on April 3, 2023, as evidence into the record. In addition, the ALJ finds the re-issued notice sufficient and the effective date regarding rates as March 1, 2023. Further, this docket is restyled as reflected in this Order.
