COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On September 23, 2022, Rio Concho Aviation, Inc (Rio Concho) filed an application to implement a pass-through rate change under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.25(b)(2) for an increase in fees billed by Northern Trinity Groundwater Conservation District (NTGCD). NTGCD raised the fee charged to Rio Concho to \$0.155 per thousand gallons effective January 1, 2022.

On October 25, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 6, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a proposed procedural schedule for further processing of the application by February 22, 2023.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 TAC § 22.4(b), a party may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requires additional time to finalize the proposed procedural schedule. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests that Staff's deadline to file a response to Order No. 6 be extended until March 8, 2023.

II. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff requests that the deadline to file a proposed procedural schedule for further processing of the application be extended until March 8, 2023.
