**ROLLING V RANCH WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 3'S
REQUEST TO RESTYLE DOCKET AND REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

On September 23, 2022, Rolling V Water Control and Improvement District No. 3 filed an application to obtain a water certificate of convenience and necessity and for dual certification with the City of Rhome in Wise County. On September 28, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 1, establishing a deadline of October 24, 2022, for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice.

I. REQUEST TO RESTYLE DOCKET

The legal name of the district that is on file with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality is "Rolling V Ranch Water Control and Improvement District No. 3 of Wise County." The filing on September 23, 2022, did not contain the words "Ranch" and "of Wise County" in the name listed on the application. Therefore, Applicant respectfully requests that the docket be restyled to "APPLICATION OF ROLLING V RANCH WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 3 OF WISE COUNTY FOR A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY AND FOR DUAL CERTIFICATION WITH THE CITY OF RHOME IN WISE COUNTY."

II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), parties may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Applicant met with Staff to discuss the mapping exhibits that were submitted with the application. The Staff requested mapping revisions in order to recommend that the application should be declared administratively complete. Therefore, the Applicant respectfully requests that the October 24, 2022, deadline be extended to November 4, 2022, to allow the Applicant to make the requested revisions and submit revised mapping exhibits to Staff. The Staff has confirmed with Applicant that they are unopposed to the extension request.

III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons discussed above, Applicant respectfully requests that the docket be restyled and that the October 24, 2022 deadline be extended to November 4, 2022.
