**ORDER NO. 18
REQUIRING CLARIFICATION, RECOMMENDATION,
AND MOTION TO ADMIT EVIDENCE**

This Order addresses the September 23, 2022 application of Rolling V Ranch Water Control and Improvement District No. 3 of Wise County's application for a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) and dual certification with the City of Rhome.

I. Need for Service

In the Order Remanding to Docket Management in Docket No. 52337,¹ the Commission discussed certain criteria for granting CCNs, specifically, the requirement that the applicant show the need for service in the requested area as dictated by Texas Water Code § 13.246(c)(2). After review of the docket, the administrative law judge is unable to locate documentation regarding the need for service as contemplated by the Commissioners in Docket No. 52337.

By April 18, 2024, Rolling V Ranch must file maps delineating tracts of land currently receiving service from Rolling V Ranch, tracts that have a service agreement with Rolling V Ranch, and tracts that have requested service from Rolling V Ranch within the requested areas. Rolling V Ranch must also file copies of each service agreement between itself and landowners within the requested areas. By May 2, 2024, Commission Staff must file a recommendation as to whether the information provided by Rolling V Ranch conforms with the Commission's determinations in Docket No. 52337.

II. Capital Improvements Plan

By April 18, 2024, Rolling V Ranch must provide information regarding the status of any capital improvements necessary to provide service to the requested areas, a capital improvements

plan for any necessary capital improvements, and any applicable information required by 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.11(e)(5). By May 2, 2024, Commission Staff must file a recommendation as to whether the information provided by Rolling V Ranch complies with the requirements of 16 TAC § 24.233(a)(6).
