**COMMISSION STAFF'S FOURTH REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

On September 23, 2022, Rolling V Ranch Water Control and Improvement District No. 3 (Rolling V WCID No. 3) filed an application to obtain a water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) and for dual certification with the City of Rhome in Wise County.

On March 28, 2024, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 18, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a recommendation as to whether the information provided by Rolling V WCID No. 3 in its response to Order No. 18 conforms with the Commission's determinations in Docket No. 52337 and complies with the requirements of 16 TAC § 24.233(a)(6) by May 2, 2024. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

**I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

In accordance with 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requires additional time to consider the Rolling V WCID No. 3's response to Order No. 18, filed on April 18, 2024, and formulate its recommendation. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests an extension of time until May 9, 2024, to file its recommendation.

**II. CONCLUSION**

Staff respectfully requests entry of an order consistent with this pleading.
