ORDER NO. 2 FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE, ESTABLISHING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE, AND SUSPENDING EFFECTIVE DATE

This Order addresses the application of Oak Bend Homeowners' Water Supply Corporation for a class D rate adjustment under Texas Water Code § 13.1871.

On October 27, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on administrative completeness of the application and notice.

The Commission finds the application administratively incomplete for the reasons specified in Sandra Hale's memorandum attached to Commission Staff's recommendation on administrative completeness filed on October 27, 2022. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.33(b)(1), the proposed effective date is suspended until an administratively complete application is submitted. Oak Bend must wait for the application to be found administratively complete before sending a new notice of proposed rate change to customers.

By November 29, 2022 Oak Bend must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies identified in the October 27, 2022 memorandum of Ms. Hale. By December 13, 2022, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding administrative completeness, notice and a proposed procedural schedule for further processing.
