

has submitted an application with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to purchase all of the water facilities and to transfer water certificated service area under CCN No. <u>11441</u> in Bosque County, TX from:

<u>The requested area overlaps the district boundaries of Brazos River Authority</u>. If this district does not request a public hearing, the Commission shall determine that the district is consenting to the <u>Monarch Utilities I LP</u>'s request to provide retail water utility service in the requested area.

Monarch has an application in process (Docket No. 53636) at the Commission to change the utility name from Monarch Utilities I L.P. to Texas Water Utilities, L.P. The docket may be approved under the new utility name.

The sale is scheduled to take place if approved by the Commission (Texas Water Code § 13.301). The transaction and the transfer of the CCN includes the following subdivision: <u>The Canyons.</u>

The requested area includes <u>178</u> customer connections, is located approximately <u>6.5</u> miles <u>west</u> of downtown <u>Whitney</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>County Road 1500 and</u> <u>Cedron Creek</u>; on the east by <u>Brazos River and Lake Whitney</u>; on the south by <u>King Creek</u>; and on the west by <u>Farm to Market 56</u>.

The requested area includes approximately <u>726</u> acres, comprised of transferred area from CCN No. 11441.

The application proposes the subtraction of approximately <u>726</u> acres from CCN No. 11441 and the addition of approximately <u>726</u> acres to CCN No. 12983.

See enclosed maps showing the requested area.

The proposed transaction may change the current customers' rates and services to the current approved rates and services of Monarch Utilities I LP, which are higher than the current rate for a 5/8" meter for <u>CS Water Corporation</u>. Persons who wish to intervene in the proceeding or comment upon action sought should contact the Public Utility Commission, P.O. Box 13326, Austin, Texas 78711-3326, or call the Public Utility Commission at (512) 936-7120 or (888) 782-8477. Hearing- and speech-impaired individuals with text telephones (TTY) may contact the commission at (512) 936-7136. The deadline for intervention in the proceeding is (30 days from the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later, unless otherwise provided by the presiding officer). You must send a letter requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date. The letter must include the person's name, address, email address and fax number if applicable.


If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.
