Re: Docket No. 54171 – APPLICATION OF MONARCH UTILITIES I LP AND CS WATER CORPORATION FOR SALE, TRANSFER, OR MERGER OF FACILITIES AND CERTIFICATE RIGHTS IN BOSQUE COUNTY

To the Commission:

Order No. 1 – Requiring Comments on Administrative Completeness, Proposed Notice, Requiring Clarification, Addressing Other Procedural Matters, and Entering Protective Order was filed in this docket on October 4, 2022. The Order requires that Monarch, by October 19, 2022, must clarify its correct name and whether the docket should be restyled. This response is timely filed.

On April 22, 2022, Monarch Utilities I L.P. (Monarch) filed with the Texas Secretary of State a Certificate of Amendment changing Monarch’s name to Texas Water Utilities, L.P. (TWU)¹. On May 23, 2022, Monarch filed an application with this Commission requesting to change the name on Monarch’s tariffs and certificates of convenience and necessity (CCN) from Monarch to TWU.² That request to change names from Monarch to TWU is still pending Commission approval. Per direction from Commission Staff, while Monarch’s business activities need to be transacted in its legal name, TWU, Monarch should continue using the Monarch name for all its business before this Commission until such time as the Commission approves the requested name change.

As explained above, Monarch should continue doing business before the Commission as Monarch, not TWU, until the Commission approves the requested name change. The inclusion of the name “Texas Water Utilities, L.P.” in Question 6A of Section C of Monarch’s application in this docket was inadvertent; “Monarch Utilities I L.P.” is the entity that should have been included as the transferee. Monarch is filing in parallel with this response to Order No. 1 a supplement to its Application making the appropriate correction. There is no need to restyle this docket; it is correctly styled as an application by Monarch.
