**Re: Docket No. 54171; Application of Texas Water Utilities, L.P. and CS Water Corporation for Sale, Transfer, or Merger of Facilities and Certificate Rights in Bosque County**

To the Commission:

In Order No. 17 issued on August 31, 2023, the administrative law judge found sufficient the supplemental notice to landowners provided on June 16, 2023.<sup>1</sup> The 120<sup>th</sup> day after June 16, 2023, was October 14, 2023, which was a Saturday. The Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) is not open for business on Saturday; therefore, the completion of the 120-day period was Monday, October 16, 2023.<sup>2</sup> Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239(i)(1), the transaction may be completed as proposed at the end of the 120-day period if the Commission does not require a hearing. It has been more than 120 days since Texas Water Utilities, L.P. (TWU) provided notice of the application, and the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) has not notified the parties that it will hold a public hearing to determine if the transaction will serve the public interest; therefore, TWU files this letter to notify the Commission that TWU and CS Water Corporation intend to close the transaction on December 18, 2023.
