ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION, AS SUPPLEMENTED, ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the September 30, 2022 application of 84 West Water Supply Corporation and the City of Mexia for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Limestone County. The applicants filed supplemental information on October 11 and 26, 2022.

On October 31, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding completeness of the application, notice, and a proposed procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner described in Jolie Mathis’s memorandum using the forms attached to Commission Staff’s October 31, 2022 filing.

The ALJ establishes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for the applicants to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with copies of the notice and map sent to the affected parties	November 30, 2022
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	December 12, 2022
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
