COMMISSION STAFF'S RECOMMENDATION ON SUFFICIENCY OF NOTICE AND PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On October 5, 2022, Wylie Northeast Special Utility District (Wylie Northeast SUD) filed an application to amend its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in Collin County. Wyle Northeast SUD hold sewer CCN No. 21056. Wylie Northeast SUD filed supplemental information on December 5, 2022, December 7, 2022, December 13, 2022, December 14, 2022, and January 10, 2023.

On February 6, 2023, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 4, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice by March 30, 2023. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. RECOMMENDATION ON NOTICE

Staff has reviewed Wylie Northeast SUD's proof of notice and recommends that the notice be found sufficient under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §§ 24.239(c) and 24.235(b)-(c). Specifically, on February 27, 2023, Wylie Northeast SUD's a Response to Order No. 4 which includes 1) signed, dated and notarized Affidavit of Notice to Neighboring Utilities, Landowners, and Affected Parties, 2) a copy of the actual notice and maps sent to the affected parties, and 3) signed, dated and notarized PUC Publisher's Affidavit form with tear sheets for the February 15th and February 23rd publications in *The Wylie News*. Wylie Northeast SUD also attached a list of the individuals and entities to whom notice was provided and included a copy of the notice and a copy of the map deemed sufficient during administrative review. Additionally, on March 27, 2023, Wylie Northeast SUD filed a Corrected Publisher's Affidavit, indicating that notice was published in a newspaper of general circulation in Collin County through *The Wylie News* on February 15, 2023, and February 22, 2023.

II. PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

In accordance with Staff recommendation that notice be found sufficient, Staff proposes the following procedural schedule:

III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff recommends that the notice be found sufficient and that the proposed procedural schedule be adopted. Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with these recommendations.
