To Whom It May Concern:

On December 14, 2022, at 9:00am a Teams meeting was conducted by PUC Staff Dave Babicki, requesting additional changes to the CCN Amendment Application – Part G: Notice Information, Item 33. This item was submitted in filing #7 on December 13, 2022. Our responses are:

• Please issue a statement that Part G: Notice Information in the application is to be disregarded. Area 1 and area 2 are to be described separately. Additionally, the shape file area 2 acreage is 73 acres.

Part G: Notice Information Item 33 in the application, dated 04 October 2022, is to be replaced with the following:

Requested Area 1

The total acreage of the requested area is approximately: 2.9

Number of customer connections in the requested area: 0

The closest city or town: St Paul

Approximate mileage to closest city or town center: 1.3

Direction to closest city or town: Southeast

The requested area is generally bounded on the North by: Aztec Trail

on the East by: Pecan Drive

on the **South** by: Parker Loop

on the West by: Southview Drive

Requested Area 2

The total acreage of the requested area is approximately: 73

Number of customer connections in the requested area: 0

The closest city or town: St Paul

Approximate mileage to closest city or town center: 1.6

Direction to closest city or town: South-Southeast

The requested area is generally bounded on the North by: Barranca Trail

on the East by: Huffines Boulevard

on the **South** by: Osage Lane

on the West by: Southview Drive

• The total acreage for all requested areas is approximately 75.9 acres.

Additionally, it was discovered after filing No. 7 there were other references to Seis Lagos Utility District decertification in other parts of the CCN Amendment Application that need clarification.

- First clarification: **Part B: Requested Area Information, item 6, page 4.** The sentence "The NORTHERN area is to be decertificated from Seis Lagos Utility District, (ref PUC Docket 53085) with zero sewer customers." <u>should be replaced</u> with "The NORTHERN area is currently an uncertificated sewer service area with zero sewer customers.".
- Second clarification: **Part B: Requested Area Information, item 7, page 4.** The checked box "Overlaps or is within district boundaries" <u>should not be checked</u>; the words "Seis Lagos Utility District" <u>should be struck</u> from the District field; the phrase "Northern area ref PUC Docket 53085" <u>should be replaced</u> with "Northern area n/a uncertificated sewer area."
