ORDER NO. 5 FINDING NOTICE, AS SUPPLEMENTED, SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE FOR CONTINUED PROCESSING

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice of 3083 Utility, LLC's application for a certificate of convenience and necessity in Montgomery County. On April 5, 2023, 3083 Utility filed the affidavits of Shelley Young, P.E., 3083 Utility's authorized representative, attesting that reissued notice of the application, along with maps of the requested area, was mailed to neighboring utilities and other affected parties on April 4, 2023.

On April 28, 2023, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on reissued notice.

On March 24, 2023, the administrative law judge (ALJ) found the notice by publication sufficient.

The ALJ finds the reissued mailed notice sufficient. The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule for continued processing of this docket:
