FINDING APPLICATION, AS SUPPLEMENTED, ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE,
REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the October 31, 2022 application of CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC and Douglas Utility Company c/o Zieben Group for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris County. CSWR-Texas filed supplemental information on November 17, 18, and 21, 2022.

On December 1, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding completeness of the application, notice, and a proposed procedural schedule.


The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner described in the memorandum of Jolie Mathis using the forms attached to Commission Staff's December 1, 2022 filing.

The ALJ establishes the following procedural schedule:

Event	Date
Deadline for the applicants to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with copies of the notice and map sent to the affected parties	January 17, 2023
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	January 27, 2023
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
