ORDER NO. 1 REQUIRING COMMISSION STAFF RECOMMENDATION

This Order addresses the November 4, 2022 application of Engie Retail, LLC dba Think Energy to relinquish its retail electric provider (REP) certificate number 10204. Engie Retail represents that on November 1, 2022, Energywell Think Holdings, LLC entered into a transaction under which it acquired 100% of the voting or equivalent equity interests in Engie Retail, which operates in 13 states (including Texas) and the District of Columbia, from its previous owner, ENGIE Resources LLC. Contemporaneously with the closing of that transaction, all of Engie Retail's Texas customers were immediately sold to Mothership Texas REP II, LLC, which holds REP Certificate No. 10324. Because Engie Retail has sold all of its Texas customers to Mothership, and will not seek to enroll any new customers in Texas, Engie Retail will not have any operations in Texas and its REP certificate number 10204 will no longer be in use and is being voluntarily relinquished.

By November 28, 2022, Commission Staff must file a recommendation on the sufficiency of the application and propose a procedural schedule, if appropriate.
