COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On December 6, 2022, Palo Duro Service Company, Inc. and the City of Hudson Oaks (collectively, Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Parker County.

On October 14, 2024, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 22, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a recommendation addressing the information provided by the Applicants by October 21, 2024. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Pursuant to 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), a party may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Commission Staff and Applicants are researching and reviewing relevant TCEQ information in order to address Order No. 22 fully and completely. Therefore, Staff respectfully requests an extension of time until October 28, 2024.

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order extending Staff's deadline to October 28, 2024 to file a recommendation addressing the information provided by the Applicants.
