RE: Request for Approval to Change Billing Method at Villas At The Parks S2667

Dear Mr. Burch:

Our company, Conservice LLC, serves as the utility billing provider for Villas At The Parks, upon whose behalf and authorization we send this letter. The purpose of this correspondence is to formally request that the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("PUC") approve this property to transition from its registered status as submetered to allocated billing.

We understand that Texas Water Code section § 13.502 permits the owner to switch from submetered to allocated billing upon a showing of good cause and approval by the PUC. Villas At The Parks is currently registered with TPUC as submetered, however, this property has no record of ever having a submetering system. We believe that the previous registration may have been a clerical error. The property does not anticipate having the capital resources required to install a submetering system, and respectfully requests that they be allowed to bill tenants through allocative methods.
