This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation for processing this proceeding filed on May 17, 2023.


On May 17, 2023, Commission Staff filed, on behalf of itself and Orange County Water Control & Improvement District No. 1, a recommendation that the most appropriate manner for processing this docket should be with the addition of an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger transaction (STM) between Orange County and Water Necessities, Inc., which occurred in 1997, to the existing application for amendment to Orange County's certificate of convenience and necessity number 10115.

Consistent with the parties' recommendation, the administrative law judge solicits an application for approval of an STM and restyles the application as reflected in this Order.

The deadlines established in Order No. 5 remain in effect.
