ORDER NO. 6
ADDRESSING APPROPRIATE PROCESSING FOR THIS
PROCEEDING, REQUIRING CLARIFICATION, AND RESTYLING DOCKET

This Order addresses Commission Staff's recommendation for processing this proceeding filed on May 17, 2023, and Commission Staff's supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness filed on June 30, 2023.

On May 17, 2023, Commission Staff filed, on behalf of itself and Orange County Water Control & Improvement District No. 1, a recommendation that the most appropriate manner for processing this docket should be with the addition of an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger transaction (STM) between Orange County and Lexington Water Systems, Inc., which occurred in 1995, to the existing application for amendment to Orange County's certificate of convenience and necessity number 10115.


On June 30, 2023, Commission Staff filed its supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness. In its recommendation, Commission Staff recommended the application be found administratively incomplete from a managerial and technical perspective, as detailed in an attached memorandum of Patricia Garcia. However, no memorandum is attached to its recommendation.

By July 13, 2023, Commission Staff must clarify whether a memorandum was inadvertently omitted and, if so, supplement its recommendation. Additionally, consistent with the parties' recommendation, the administrative law judge solicits an application for approval of an STM.

This docket is restyled as reflected in this Order.
