ORDER NO. 10 FINDING NOTICE INSUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of notice of Orange County Water Control & Improvement District No. 1 and Lexington Water Systems' application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Orange County.

In Order No. 9 filed on November 3, 2023, the applicants were ordered to file proof of notice by December 4, 2023. To date, the applicants have not filed proof of notice.

On December 18, 2023, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on the sufficiency of notice. In its recommendation, Commission Staff represented that the applicants are working to resolve an outstanding discrepancy in order to provide proper notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice insufficient. The following procedural schedule applies:

Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	February 1, 2024
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
