**ORDER NO. 3  
GRANTING EXTENSION**

This Order addresses Orange County Water Control and Improvement District No. 1's February 9, 2023 request for an extension. Orange County WCID states that it requires additional time to gather information and amend its application. Orange County WCID represents that Commission Staff is unopposed to the request.

The administrative law judge grants the request. By February 28, 2023, the applicant must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the January 12, 2023 memorandum of Patricia Garcia. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicant must not issue notice until the application is found to be administratively complete.

By March 28, 2023, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
