ORDER NO. 3 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of Forest Glen Utility Company's December 16, 2022 application to amend its sewer certificate of convenience and necessity number 21070 in Medina County. On February 15 and March 2 and 3, 2023, Forest Glen provided supplements to its application.

On March 16, 2023, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness, provided instructions and forms for providing notice, and proposed a procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs Forest Glen to provide notice of the application as described in the memorandum of Jaspinder Singh attached to Commission Staff's March 16, 2023 recommendation, using the included forms.
