**ORDER NO. 15  
REQUIRING CLARIFICATION**

This Order addresses the March 18, 2024 joint motion to admit evidence and March 19, 2024 amended joint motion to admit evidence filed by Forest Glen Utility Company and Commission Staff.

The administrative law judge requires the parties to clarify why they did not move to admit Commission Staff's supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of notice filed September 8, 2023, into the record of this proceeding.
