**ORDER NO. 1
REQUIRING COMMISSION STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

This Order addresses the compliance filings and status updates of the City of Lubbock, acting by and through Lubbock Power and Light (LP&L), and the Electric Reliability Council of Texas (ERCOT).

In ordering paragraph eight of the Commission’s Order in Docket No. 53529¹ (the Commission’s Order), LP&L was ordered to calculate and provide its four-coincident-peak (4CP) data to ERCOT and the Commission. In ordering paragraph 11, LP&L and ERCOT were ordered to provide updates or raise issues regarding the integration of LP&L’s remaining load into ERCOT.

LP&L and ERCOT filed joint status reports on May 5, August 4, October 25, November 13, and December 8 and 12, 2023. LP&L filed its 2022 4CP data on November 27, 2023.

By January 8, 2024, Commission Staff must file comments and recommendations on the sufficiency of LP&L and ERCOT’s compliance filings, whether all of LP&L and ERCOT’s compliance obligations associated with the Commission’s Order have been satisfied, and whether this compliance docket can be closed.
