In September of 2022, we where notified of the change in ownership of the water facility and water service with the assurance that the water rated will remain unchanged at the time. In just a few short months we are now being notified of a proposed rate change of a very astronomical amount. The current rate is \$22.75 per month which includes 1000 gallons. The proposed rate of \$54.03 which includes zero gallons. I very rarely go over the 1000 gallons per month. If you add \$5.53 for the first 1000 gallons, my new rate is about \$59.56 per month. That represents an over 261% increase. I do not know what additional expenses that CSWR is incurring over the prior operator of the utility. I find it unreasonable to think that that sort of increase is in order. If they cannot operate as efficiently as the prior owner, they should not have made such an investment.

I am unable to find comparable rates of other local water districts. However, I did find information furnish by the City of Fort Worth that the average cost to supply 5000 gallons a month to its customers was \$39 in 2022. This compares to the proposed rate of CSWR of \$81.68 for 5000 gallons.
