PUC Docket No. 54565 Protest Comments

- The proposed increase obviously exceeds the present rate of inflation. While it is certainly normal to expect periodic rate increases, this 300% increase is unreasonable and highly objectionable. For this reason alone, the Commission is requested to decline the application as submitted.
- The proposed formula (now a fixed rate vs. gallonage usage) does not promote water conservation, a key environmental concern consistently expressed by our own city leaders and the San Antonio Water System (SAWS).
- The proposed formula (now a fixed rate vs. gallonage usage) discriminates against those who require less water usage due to smaller household size, lot size, etc. and against those who do make an effort to conserve water.
