Dear Public Utility Commission of Texas

I am writing this letter as a protest to the referenced increase in the above PUC docket, #54565.

I understand that when a smaller institution is purchased by a larger one increases in billings will happen, after all we are feeding a larger animal and all are expected to contribute. However an increase of (\$31.75 per 5,000 gals to \$81.68 per 5,000 gals) is excessive and in my opinion ridiculous!

As a consumer of these services my understanding from the letter I received is that CSWR wants an increase because it wants to "rectifying issues related to all aspects of its facilities". What they have not been operating at a profit? They just now found out they have "rectifying" issues.

How many rate increases have they required before acquiring Lake Limestone? Our small community at Lake Limestone has been operating at about a 13% profit and as far as I have heard there have been no major issues that have resulted in a need for a rate increase. They need a 3.9 million operating increase to continue operations efficiently? That doesn't even mention the 1.1 million increase they want for the wastewater.

I would like to ask, what is a "non-discharging septic system"? It certainly is not the one I have in my yard which I am required to maintain, as are most of the people at this Lake.

I am not expecting that you will not give CSWR some amount of increase but I am asking you to make it reasonable. Does an increase from \$31.75 to \$81.68 seem right? That is over 100%!

Thank you for taking my concerns in to account.
