I am filing this, regarding the: RATEPAYER COMMENTS/REQUESTS TO INTERVENE due to the following reasons:

1.) We have been lumped into one large community, being all of CSWR's customers in Texas, not just our individual community. (This applies to the rate increase and said repairs needed.)

2.) Wastewater services are NOT necessary for our community, yet we would be penalized for those services as part of the requested rate increase.

3.) Our community has not been informed by CSWR on their plan of action for any improvements on our water system, or provided a timeline in which such work would be performed on OUR water system.

4.) CSWR has not performed a "test year" on our system, nor have they even owned our water system for a full year.
