Notice of Proposed Rate Change

Pursuant To Texas Water Code 13.1871 and 13.18715

Response: The sewer providers are charging a rate of \$21.56 per the first 5000 gallons of usage and then an increase for all usage afterwards is what is presently in place. Wanting to increase 300% to 66.65 per the first 5000 gallons is an outrage.

My concern is not only that of a tremendous increase but also the fact that most residences in my area have Irrigation Systems installed. Each residence has roughly an average of 1300 gallons of water per cycle and residences with larger yards are using many more gallons than that just watering once a week. In effect, the usage for a month would be 5200 gallons at a minimum that never enters the sewer yet, the homeowners are being charged for usage?? How can homeowners be charged for a service that is not being used.

I shut my Irrigation System down for the Winter months and my usage was still 3740 gallons this past January. My average for 2022 alone with the Irrigation System was 25,000 gallons. Paying for sewer usage for over 20,000 gallons monthly when it is not being used is not only ludicrous, but in my opinion—robbery!

A solution that is fair and acceptable to us would be the provision of an irrigation meter <u>separate</u> from the domestic meter at <u>your</u> expense. What you are currently proposing to us to be kind--is excessive.

The gallon usage figures that were aforementioned in this letter were on a Phase 2 Watering Schedule. Irrigation usage is much higher during a normal Watering Schedule with no restrictions.
