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To Whom it may concern,

I object to the proposed rate increase of approximately 155% by CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC and request to be granted <u>intervenor</u> status on behalf of customers of the legacy Lake Limestone Coves Water System. This rate increase is grossly excessive and predatory in nature. CSWR recently completed the purchase of our legacy water supply company, Lake Limestone Coves Water System, Inc (Docket #53456) in September 2022. In their initial Notice to Customers concerning this purchase dated 5/19/2022, their letter states that the purchase includes 424 customers and that "This transaction <u>will not</u> have an effect on the current customer's rates and services". This statement allayed impacted customers fears resulting in few objections to the purchase, and little if any protests were filed with PUC. After the purchase was approved by PUC and finalized, a welcome letter was sent by CSWR on 9/21/22 announcing the completion of the sale and it also states "Your current rate for water will remain unchanged at this time". We recently received a Notice of Proposed Rate Change dated 2/3/2023 that would have the minimum monthly rate increase by 137% and the more typical household monthly bill increase by approximately 155% (see table below).

CSWR has not acted in good faith and their acquisition of small water supply systems in Texas is predatory in nature. In our case, 424 customers make up the legacy Lake Limestone Coves Water System which was operated profitably for at least the last 10 years at the previous rate structure. CSWR purchased the system and lumped it and us 424 customers into an "umbrella" water supply company that entails approximately 74 different water supply systems and 8350 customers.

CSWR is seeking an increase of  $^{3.5}$  million over current revenue, the proposed rate increase for our system would generate \$286,417 of that revenue. The 424 customers on this water system account for only  $^{5\%}$  of the total CSWR customers, however this rate increase would burden us with  $^{8\%}$  of the

overall \$3.5 million revenue increase. While to date, outside of normal maintenance, there have been no improvements or investments in the water system providing service to us 424 customers.

I am requesting the PUC grant me <u>intervenor</u> status and to hold a public hearing and subsequently reject this excessive rate increase. I would also request that the PUC investigate the business practices and actions of CSWR for predatory behavior and take any actions available to protect the citizens of Texas from further damage.
